Responsibilities: The State Field Director will be responsible for organizing efforts throughout Wisconsin. Specifically responsibilities include:

1. Assist in the development of and be responsible for executing statewide field plans for each of the three entities, comprised of electoral and legislative civic engagement and direct election campaign components;
 2. Recruit, train, and manage local area organizers, both paid and volunteer, and student interns, to execute the field plans;
 3. Coordinate and support activities of numerous local Action Networks and Students for a Fair Wisconsin campus groups;
 4. Travel extensively within the state to support and coordinate the activities of local organizers, interns, Action Networks and Students for a Fair Wisconsin;
 5. Develop and maintain working relationships with strategic partners, labor union representatives, faith leaders, elected officials and other constituency groups in order to leverage field efforts;
 6. Provide regular reports, work plans and strategic plans to Deputy Executive Director; and
 7. Perform other responsibilities as directed by the Deputy Executive Director.

Organization Description: Fair Wisconsin, the Fair Wisconsin Education Fund, and the Fair Wisconsin PAC are non-profit organizations dedicated to fighting for fairness for Wisconsin's lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender residents. Fair Wisconsin Education Fund, a 501(c)(3) organization, does this primarily through educating the public about existing discriminatory laws. Fair Wisconsin's 501(c)(4) entity primarily engages in advocacy campaigning and lobbying work to achieve these goals. The Fair Wisconsin PAC provides direct and indirect financial support to candidates and election efforts to further these goals.

Fair Wisconsin Education Fund and Fair Wisconsin raised and spent a combined \$5.3 million dollars from 12,000 donors and mobilized thousands of volunteers to fight the state's constitutional amendment referendum in 2006 banning gay marriage, civil unions, and domestic partnerships. They are the successor organizations to Action Wisconsin and the Action Wisconsin Education Fund.
